

Assistant Swim Coach Summer 2021

Beacon Hill Club is looking for an Assistant Swim Coach to join our team in the upcoming 2021 summer season. This position works with children of all ages and possesses the capabilities and maturity to handle responsibilities involved in maintaining a safe pool.

The Assistant Swim Coach will assist the Head Swim Coach in the day to day operations of the summer swim team program, starting June 1st for eight weeks. During the pre-season, practices and meets are held Monday through Friday during late afternoon and early evening hours. Once the season starts, and school is out, practices will be held in the mornings. The Assistant Swim Coach will also have the opportunity to teach private swim lessons.

The ideal candidate will be motivated, responsible and want to coach competitive swimming. They will also have at least 1 year experience in a similar role, and experience as a competitive swimmer.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Lead weekly swim team practices under the direction of the Head Swim Coach
- Attend all swim meets, practices, and events to support swimmers
- Assist with creating meet lineups and organization of team swim meets throughout summer season
- Provide training direction to help swimmers master technique
- Adjust coaching techniques based on the needs of each individual swimmer
- Help ensure safety and respectful conduct of all team swimmers at all times
- Know, understand and apply safety rules, policies and guidelines for all swim team events and practices
- Report any suspicious or inappropriate behaviors to Head Swim Coach
- Assist Head Swim Coach with coordinating team parents throughout the season
- Support the Head Swim Coach with maintaining a clean pool and locker room areas during swim team program times

Requirements:

- High School Diploma or Equivalent
- At least 1 year experience as a swim coach, former or current competitive swimmer preferred
- Ability to communicate effectively with parents, staff and guests
- CPR/ AED First Aid Certification
- Safety Training for Coaches certification preferred
- Must be available to work the full swim team season, attend regular staff meetings and complete all required trainings
